Field of Interest Funds

These funds connect people with their passions and specific areas of need in their community. Education, the arts, the environment and disadvantaged youth and families are a few areas donors can support through these funds. WCCF will award grants to individuals/community organizations and programs that are making a difference in the areas YOU select. Maintenance of the fund is left to the Community Foundation.

Establishing a Field of Interest Fund is

Strategic: Enables the Community Foundation to address the changing community needs in the areas you designate.

Easy: Charitable funds are being wisely invested, managed and granted.

Flexible: Add to the fund at any time. The Community Foundation can accept donations of almost any asset.

Accountable: Access information about your fund anytime, and receive quarterly statements that show all activity in your fund.


Our staff continually monitor changing community needs to ensure grants make the most impact in your field of interest and **create your own personal legacy of giving.**

Affiliated Community Funds

While there are a number of organizations and trusts that manage donor funds and make grants, **WCCF is the only organization in the West Coast region that use grassroots philanthropy as a development tool.** We're putting boots on the ground to build leadership, engage young people and support entrepreneurship so communities across the region realizes the role they can play in building a prosperous future.

We provide development to affiliated funds including community-driven funds – all in rural areas – such as the YouthBank Funds of Nuwerus, Eendekuil and Graafwater.

We also serve individual donors and their families, by helping them establish charitable funds to benefit their communities and favourite causes, such as the Fred Williams Community Fund, who has dedicated monthly donors.



MEMBERSHIP & STRUCTURE

Individuals and businesses become members of the Affiliated Community Fund by making an annual donation of at least R2 000.

- The first 100 members who commit R2 000 or more per year for five years will be designated "Founders"
- Half of the money goes immediately into annual grant-making
- 35% of the money goes into building a permanent endowment (a fund that builds assets for the affiliated community fund's long-term sustainability)
- 15% of the funds are used by the West Coast Community Foundation for fund administration purposes
- All members vote annually to determine which organization receive grant awards.
- All funds will go through an Annual Financial audit.
